Strategic Location

Where Germany meets the world.

Centrally located in the middle of Germany, the Frankfurt RheinMain region is one of the most important transportation hubs in Europe. Within a radius of just 200 km (124 miles), you can reach some 47 million people. In this strategic location, people and goods are constantly on the move – by air, road and rail.

Global exhibition and trading center

The Frankfurt RheinMain region attracts over two million global visitors to trade fairs and international conventions on an annual basis, making it one of the leading trade fair locations in Europe. International trade has a long history in the region, dating back to as far as the year 1240 when Emperor Frederick II approved the inaugural Frankfurt Autumn Trade Fair. Since then, Frankfurt has constantly expanded its fairgrounds to nearly 400,000 square metres, making it one of the largest of its kind worldwide. The trade fair industry is a job engine and the source of our international DNA.

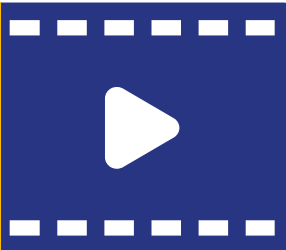

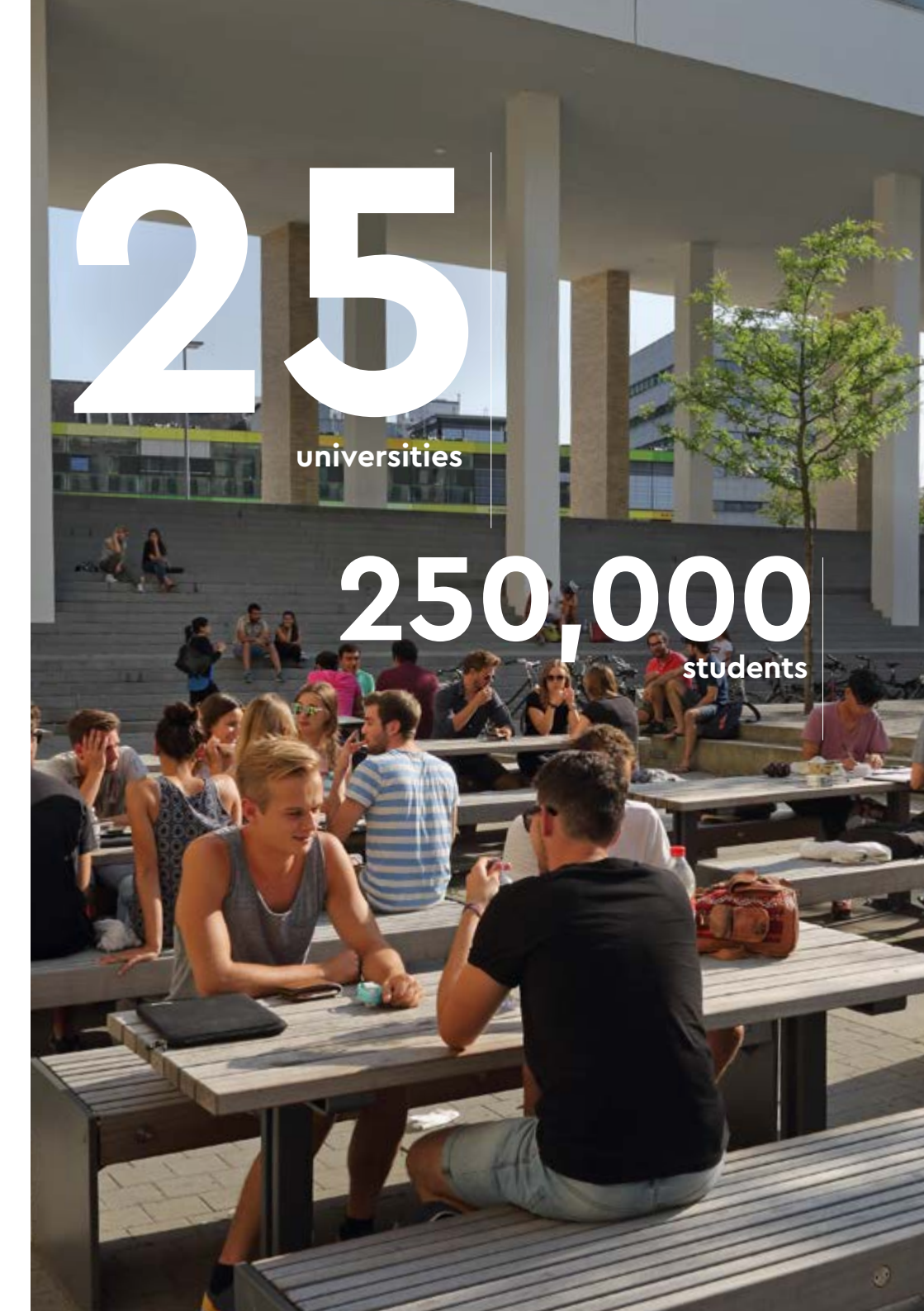
